In politics...

1. At the end of January, the legal proposition in support of euthanasia was rejected by the French Senate. Thank God for hearing the prayers of the strong mobilization of Christians against this act, as well as for those involved with the "Alliance pour les Droits de la Vie."
2. On February 7th, Sarkozy traveled to Warsaw for the Weimar Triangle Summit. Created in 1991, this summit aims to improve relations between Poland, Germany, and France. Pray that God will bless French-German-Polish relations, and that their improvement would bless the rest of Europe by extension.

In society...

1. The National Assembly held discussions concerning bioethical legislature this month. Pray for God to bless those who defend the right to life, naming specific people and associations with which you are familiar. Pray for a strong mobilization of prayer to continue towards the National Assembly, and pray for life to be respected in France.
2. Sarkozy held an annual dinner for the Conseil Représentatif des Institutions Juives de France ("Representative Council of French Jewish Institutions"). While this dinner aims to maintain a French stance against anti-Semitism, the Jewish people of France worry that the country's political relations with Israel do not always reflect a respect for their religion. Pray that France would move beyond courtesy and convenience to an enlightened and courageous politics.
